Expectations

Worship Leader

- Bring music sets to rehearsal
- Arrive early and have lights on
- Start practice on time
- Be efficient in practice
- Schedule music and people ahead of time

Worship Team

- Come focused and ready to play/sing at the start of practice
- Limit talking/jamming and give attention to leader
- Wednesday practice is required in order to play on **Sunday**.

Scheduling Expectations

-We will be planning worship teams mid-month for the following month. In order to be scheduled to play/sing, let us know any conflicts you have by the 15th of the previous month. We need to know when you are available in order to schedule you. We want to work around your schedules, but we need your help to avoid conflicts.
